Subject: Survey city, town and parish allowances - Wiltshire Independent Remuneration Panel

The Independent Remuneration Panel is undertaking a review of city, town, and parish allowances within the Wiltshire unitary authority area.

City, town, and parish councils can choose to pay their members an allowance, known as a 'parish basic allowance', to recognise the time and effort councillors put into their parish duties. They may also make an allowance available to its Chairman. There is no obligation on councils to pay any allowances or for councillors to accept an allowance.

No review of city, town and parish allowances has been undertaken in Wiltshire since the county became a unitary authority in 2009 and the Panel is looking to devise a standard scheme, fair to all, which towns and parishes can refer to if they wish to pay allowances.

The Panel is therefore circulating a survey to all city, towns, and parish clerks (closing date

28 October 2024) to understand the current position regarding allowances and to capture comments and suggestions. The Clerk or Responsible Financial Officer (RFO) can also invite the members of the authority to complete a separate response to the survey.

The Panel may follow up certain responses but only from respondents who have agreed to be contacted. If respondents wish to be interviewed/meet the panel, then the panel will make every effort to meet such requests.
