

Subject: A360 Black Dog Crossroads - Signal Installation Update

Dear Councillors,

I am pleased to be providing an update on the traffic signal installation on the A360 at Black Dog Crossroads.

I attach for your information the latest general layout showing the junction improvements. The speed limit reduction will also go forward alongside the signal installation.

SSE are due to start work on the provision of the electrical supply from 3rd Sept with expected completion on the 19th Oct. They will be excavating a trench and laying approx. 550m new cables mostly in the carriageway along the A360 from near Frieth Farm to the crossroads. During this time, there will be two way temporary signals in place until the works reach the crossroads, when 4 way signals will be needed.

The signal installation works will then begin from the 20th October for approximately 13 weeks (excluding shut down for the Christmas break). During this time, temporary signals will be in place on the A360 and closures will be needed on the side road arms. We are currently working with our contractor to finalise the details around this, with a particular focus on how to retain access for over-height vehicles on Broadway and to minimise the impact on school transport. I will update with more details on this as these discussions progress. Local businesses and our Passenger Transport Unit have been contacted with regard to their requirements and we will continue to liaise as needed.

In addition to the signal installation and speed limit change, we are also accommodating drainage system repairs within the traffic management to reduce any future issues and disruption. Carriageway surfacing will also take place.

We will be making information available to the wider public shortly through our communications team and I will keep you updated with more details as construction progresses. If at any time you have any queries regarding this project, please do contact me.
